## Provider Network Development for MississippiCAN

The Division of Medicaid (DOM) is implementing a new coordinated care program called Mississippi Coordinated Access Network (MississippiCAN). DOM will be contracting with two coordinated care organizations (CCOs) – Magnolia Health Plan and United Healthcare – who will be responsible for providing services to Mississippi Medicaid beneficiaries. The CCOs are now in the process of developing provider networks and have begun contacting Mississippi Medicaid providers. For some services, the CCOs may subcontract with vendors to provide services (i.e. Dental, Vision, DME, etc.).

Medicaid beneficiaries included in the targeted populations for the MississippiCAN program include individuals in the following categories of eligibility:

- SSI
- Disabled Child at Home
- Working Disabled
- Department of Human Services Foster Care
- Breast/Cervical Cancer Group

Enrollment of the targeted populations will be voluntary. All beneficiaries will have the ability to choose the coordinated care organization (CCO) of their choice. Enrolled beneficiaries will have an open enrollment period during the 90 days following their initial enrollment in a CCO during which they can enroll in a different CCO or opt out of the program. Eligibility criteria for MississippiCAN will be the same as the eligibility criteria for Mississippi Medicaid.
