Appropriate Treatment for Upper Respiratory Infection (URI)	Consider treatment of URI symptoms without using Antibiotics	
Imaging Studies and Back Pain	Treat conservatively without X-ray for 28 days unless trauma, hx. CA, or comorbidity

Initiation/Engagement of Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse Treatment	Initiation: Initiate treatment within 14 days of diagnosis Engagement: Schedule follow up appointment 2 and 4 weeks after initial appointment	98960-98962, 99078, 99201 -99205, 99211 - 99215, 99241 -99245 Not all inclusive
